June 4 - Day 1 - Thursay - Travel Day



Travel Day - (Airfare Under Separate Arrangements)

- On the eve of our tour, we fly from Texas to London Heathrow Airport. (Flights are not included in the package pricing)

June 5 - Day 2 - Friday - Arrive London



Welcome to London!

- Arrive at London Heathrow Airport (LHR), meet your local Guide/assistant & transfer to the hotel aboard a private motor coach.
- Upon arrival at hotel, check-in and rest of the day at leisure to explore on own.
- Everyone will receive London Oyster cards (British pounds 20) each.
- Later, make your own way to Imperial War Museum.
- In the evening, walk to a local restaurant for welcome dinner (2 courses, plus drinking water)
- Overnight at The Tower hotel, London or similar category.

June 6 - Day 3 - Saturday - London



Full day sightseeing tour of London

- Full English buffet breakfast at the hotel is included.
- Today, embark on a full day city sightseeing tour on your own using public transport.
- Use of Oyster card/public transport pass.
- Entrance to the [Churchill War Rooms & Imperial War Museum](#), followed by entrance to [HMS Belfast](#)
- Overnight stay at The Tower Hotel, London or similar category.

June 7 - Day 4 - Sunday - Arrive Bournemouth



Tour of Southwick & transfer to Bournemouth

- Full English buffet breakfast at the hotel & check out of your rooms.
- Board your private motor coach for a transfer to [Southwick](#) with full day of excursions - (2 hours' drive)
- Morning visit to [Southwick House](#)
- Transfer to [Portsmouth](#) - (15 mins drive)
- Visit the [D-Day Museum and Overlord Embroidery](#)
- Stop to view the [D-Day Landing Craft](#)
- Transfer to [Bournemouth](#) - (1.5 hours' drive) & check-in to your hotel. Remainder of the day free at leisure.
- Overnight at Hilton Bournemouth or similar category.

June 8 - Day 5 - Monday - Arrive Bayeux



Ferry to Cherbourg & transfer to Bayeux

- Start your day with a full English buffet breakfast at the hotel.
- **07:15 AM** - Private motor coach transfer to [Poole harbor](#) - (15 mins drive)
- **07:30 AM** - Check in for ferry.
- **08:30 AM** - Ferry to Cherbourg - foot passenger one way
- **2:00 PM** - Arrive Cherbourg and transfer by private motor coach to [Ste Mere Eglise](#) - (45 mins drive)
- Stop to view the church with the Paratrooper on the roof
- Visit the [Airborne Museum](#)
- Transfer by private motor coach to Bayeux (1 hour drive)
- Overnight stay at Novotel Bayeux or similar category.

June 9 - Day 6 - Tuesday - Bayeux



Bayeux - Bayeux Tapestry, Landing Beaches Vists

- Continental buffet breakfast at the hotel
- Private motor coach transportation for the day & begin with a transfer to Lion Sur Mer (1 hour drive)
- Visit to the [Sword Beach](#), easternmost beach of the Normandy landings in June 1944.
- Afterwards, transfer to Ver sur Mer - (40 mins drive) & stop at [Gold beach](#), followed by transfer to [Arromanches](#), (15 mins drive) stop to view the remains of the Mulberry harbour in the sea, just off the shore
- Later, transfer to [Longues](#) Sur Mer - (30 mins drive) & visit the German battery on the cliffs.
- Transfer to Bayeux - (15 mins drive)
- Overnight stay at Novotel Bayeux or similar category.



Bayeux

Bayeux boasts a stunning historic centre as well as its world-famous, UNESCO-listed tapestry depicting the Norman conquest of England in 1066. The city had the good fortune to be swiftly liberated by the Allies in June 1944, but its war museum and British cemetery recall the sacrifices made in these parts.

June 10 - Day 7 - Wednesday - Bayeux



Visit the Beaches of Normandy including Omaha & Utah Beach, Visit the American Cemetery,

- Continental buffet breakfast in hotel
- Private motor coach transfer to [St Laurent sur Mer](#) (Private motor coach to remain with the group for the day) - (30 mins drive)
- Stop to view the [Omaha beach](#) & visit to the [American Cemetery](#)
- Afterwards, transfer to Pointe du Hoc (30 mins drive) & stop to view the site where Rangers scaled the cliffs.
- Later, transfer on to Sainte-Marie du Mont (30 mins drive) & entrance to the [Utah Beach Landing Museum](#) with a guided tour.
- Later, transfer to Bayeux - (1 hour drive)
- Overnight stay at Novotel Bayeux or similar category.

June 11 - Day 8 - Thursday - Arrive Paris



Bayeux to Compiegne with a stop at Caen Memorial Museum

- Continental buffet breakfast in hotel & check out of the hotel today.
- Private Motor Coach Transfer to Caen (motor coach to remain with group for the day) (30 mins drive)
- Visit the [Caen Memorial Museum](#) including audio guide.
- Afterwards, transfer to Paris (4 hours drive)
- Overnight stay at Hotel Pullman Montparnasse or similar category.

June 12 - Day 9 - Friday - Arrive Reims



Visit Liberation Museum & transfer to Reims

- Continental buffet breakfast in hotel & check out of the hotel.
- Private motor coach to remain with the group for the day
- First stop is to visit the [Liberation Museum](#) in Paris & enjoy some free time in Paris.
- Later, transfer on to Reims (2.5 hours' drive) & check-in at your hotel.
- Remainder of the day is free at leisure.
- Overnight stay at Hotel Radisson Reims or similar category.

June 13 - Day 10 - Saturday - Arrive Wiltz

Visit Meuse Argonne American Cemetery & transfer to Wiltz



- Continental buffet breakfast in hotel & check out of your hote.
- Private motor coach transfer (coach to remain with the group for the day) to Meuse-Argonne area - (2 hours drive)
- Stop to view the significant World War II sites along the way.
- Visit the [Meuse Argonne American Cemetery](#)
- Later, transfer on to Wiltz (4 hours drive)
- Arrive at your hotel in Wiltz and check-in. Remainder of the day free at leisure.
- Overnight stay at Aux Tanneries de Wiltz Hotel or similar category.

June 14 - Day 11 - Sunday - Arrive Arnhem



Visit Bastogne barracks & War Museum & transfer to Arnhem

- Start your day with continental buffet breakfast at the hotel. Later, check out of your hotel.
- Start with a transfer to Bastogne (30 mins drive) to visit the [Bastogne Barracks](#)
- Afterwards, visit the [Bastogne War Museum](#) (Battle of the Bulge)
- Later, transfer to Arnhem (4 hours drive)
- Overnight stay at Hotel Bastion or similar category.

June 15 - Day 12 - Monday - Arrive Amsterdam



View War Sites in and around Arnhem & transfer to Amsterdam

- Continental buffet breakfast in hotel
- A private motor coach will be provided and will remain with the group for the entire day.
- During the visit in [Arnhem](#), there will be a scheduled stop to view the renowned John Frost bridge. This historic bridge holds great significance as it played a significant role during the famous Battle of Arnhem in World War II.
- As you arrive at the [John Frost Bridge](#), you will have the opportunity to admire its impressive structure and learn about its historical importance. The bridge gained international recognition as it was a key objective for the British forces during Operation Market Garden in 1944.
- View key sites related to [Operation Market Garden](#). Operation Market Garden was a significant military operation during World War II, aimed at capturing key bridges in the Netherlands to secure a direct route to Germany.
- Proceed to Oosterbeek/Hartestein, which is approximately 15 mins drive away.
- Entrance to the [Airborne Museum](#) & later further transfer to Amsterdam.
- Upon arrival, check in to your hotel & remainder of the day free at leisure.
- Overnight stay at Movenpick hotel, Amsterdam or similar category.

June 16 - Day 13 - Tuesday - Amsterdam



Amsterdam City Tour

- Continental buffet breakfast in hotel
- Private motor coach on with the group for full day in Amsterdam.
- Start with entrance to Anne Frank House- (subject to availability)
- Entrance to the [Resistance Museum](#). Afterwards, remainder of the afternoon is free at leisure to explore Amsterdam on own.
- In the evening, we walk to a local restaurant nearby the hotel for Farewell dinner (2 course meal with drinking water).
- Overnight stay at Movenpick hotel, Amsterdam or similar category.



Anne Frank House

- The Anne Frank House is the hiding place where Anne Frank wrote her famous diary during World War II. Now a museum, it recreates the war and holocaust years. Quotations from the diary, photographs, films and original objects belonging to the people in hiding and those who helped them all serve to illustrate the events which occurred at this location. Anne's original diary is on display in the museum as well.
